key features of the Bill

4 Bill will provide statutory status to three regulatory anstitutions

(i) Directorate General of civil Aviation (DGCA)

(ii) Bureau of civil Aviation security (BCAS) (iii) Aircraft Accident Invultigation Gureau (AAIB)

4 Bill propose to increase the fine amount for violations

of rules from RE 10 lakhs to 1 crore. Power of the centre to make rules on matter like registration of aircraft, regulating air transport services and prohibition of flight over any specified area.

IJ Exemption of aircraft belonging to armed forces

of the union.

Naval, military or air forces are almady exempted from the provision of the act
