-NATGRID:

- · It is the integrated intelligence grid connecting databases of core security agencies of the Government of India.
- · A robust intel gathering mechanism related to immigration, banking, individual taxpayers, air and train travels.
- · First conceptualised in 2009, after the Mumbai terror attacks.
- ·NATGRID seeks to become the one-stop destination for security and intel agencies
- · The data will be procured by NATGRID from 21 organisations such as telecom, tax records, bank, immigration, etc.

Drug haul: role of Pakistani elements being examined

3,000 kilograms of heroin were seized by the Indian law enforcement agencies at Gujarat's Mundra Port.

The drugs were shipped from Afghanistan. The seized heroin was exported by a Kandahar-based trader and imported by Vijayawada-based trading company via Bandar Abbas Port, Iran to Gujarat's Mundra Port. Role of Afghanistan in drug trafficking:

The seizure of this large haul of heroin raises serious questions about the Taliban's promise to stop drug production and its trade

Drug trafficking remains one of the biggest sources of income and funding for the Taliban.

Notably, after the Taliban announced a ban on the production and supply of narcotics, the rate of heroin and opium almost doubled within a few days in the local and international markets.

Afghanistan controls 80 to 90 per cent of opium and heroin supply in the world, according to the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC).

Security threat to India:

The Indian investigators are still trying to find out the purpose of the import of such a huge quantity of heroin in India. Narcotics trade has been used for decades to fund terrorist activities inside India. On regular basis, consignments of drugs are seized at the Punjab and Jammu borders which are sent from Pakistan to fund terrorist organisations.
